1. High-Level Double Materiality Exercise

2. High-Level Value Chain Impact Assessment

- **Overview:** This assessment involves identifying impacts across lifecycle stages in the company's value chain to position sustainability themes and focus areas.
- **Process:** Similar to the double materiality exercise, this assessment uses facilitated sessions with executives to map and evaluate the sustainability impacts at each stage of the value chain.
- **Deliverable:** A comprehensive document is provided, summarising the identified impacts and suggested focus areas.

3. GRI or ESRS Gap Analysis

- **Overview:** This exercise offers an option for either a Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) or European Sustainability Reporting Standards (ESRS) gap analysis.
- **Process:** Using the results from the high-level double materiality exercise, the analysis positions disclosures and metrics for the company, identifying gaps between current practices and the selected reporting standards.

- **Deliverable:** A detailed report outlining the gaps and recommendations for alignment with either the GRI or ESRS standards.
